In 1957, when Ann, who lived in Boston at the time, was 7, her Aunt Phillis Fuller, told the family the Fuller Family came over on the Mayflower. Her aunt had been doing research into this since the 40's and had hit a "brick wall".

She asked my mom to try to do some research at the Boston Genealogical Society. Mom took me with her into Boston to search the microfiche. And I was hooked.

It took Ann 50 years to prove the connection to the Mayflower, but it came in an unexpected way.
