



At this point your ios device (iphone / ipad) will display all the applications you may choose for your home screen.


For each app you choose you will be given options/functions to include.

Click on "Calls"


Assistive Access – Configure Calls








Assistive Access – More Apps






Choose the Apps that you want added to your home screen.

Re-enter the Assistive Access Passcode.






Get Help If You Forget Your Assistive Access Passcode










Assistive Access – Exit or Modify


To EXIT Assistive Access at any time, Triple-click the side button (on an iPhone with Face ID) or the Home button (on other iPhone models), tap Exit Assistive Access, then enter the Assistive Access passcode. You need to exit Assistive Access to do any of the following: Change most Assistive Access and system settings.





Assistive Access - Modify

Once you are back at your Home Screen, then start again to apply changes to your options —orto re-enter Assistive Access.








BIG LAUNCHER





- Large font and different colors used to display the message thread.






To get out of BIG LAUNCHER, just close the App.



Android Home Screen Findings



Android devices require add-on - 3rd party applications.

Because these are all separate Apps, you can download each one and configure them individually. You can run them side by side and determine which you like the best – then delete (uninstall) the ones you don't want.

You can Hide All The Apps you don't care about that clutter up your device.

Each developer has approached the solution differently, so you may find one that better suites you.

If your situation changes in the future, look for a different App to handle your needs.



Android has approached this by encouraging developers to provide customizable interfaces. The benefit is that the solutions vary by developer (each have a personality that may better suite the personality of the owner). A problem may be that there are a lot of apps to check out before you find one that fits you.



Apple has approached this creating a customizable environment for the device owner. The benefit is that the solution is the same for all device owners, so support is easier to provide. A problem may be that it's Apple's way or the Highway - if it doesn't fit you, then too bad.

Both businesses have helped device owners to improve their experiences by increasing the visual interfaces of their products on both their smartphones and tablet/ipad devices. WIN <-> WIN !!
